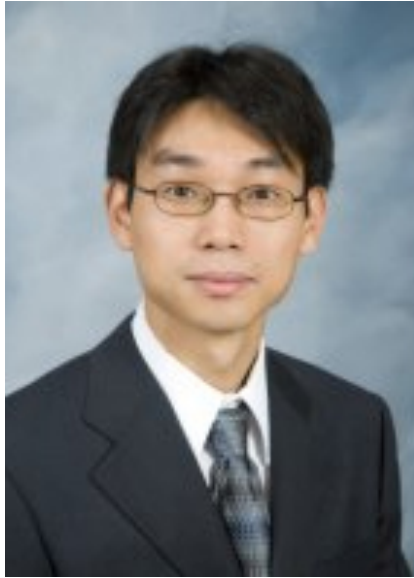


Changhe Yuan Receives NSF Career Award



Dr. Changhe Yuan, assistant professor of Computer Science and Engineering at Mississippi State University, has been awarded an NSF CAREER grant. The title of his award is “CAREER: Explanation, Decision Making, and Learning in Graphical Models.” Funded by the Robust Intelligence program in the CISE Division of Information and Intelligent Systems (IIS), Yuan will develop new and improved approaches to explanation, decision making, and learning in graphical models in addressing the limited adaptability and scalability of existing methods. This project will lead to significantly better approaches to reasoning and decision making under uncertainty in many disciplines where graphical models have found successful applications, including biology, medicine, security, planning, education, and many others.
